Dear Chairman Wylock:

This office did its enforcement action by issuing the stop work order! The vehicles, if considered construction vehicles, of which it could be argued all are – bucket loader, tank trailer, dump truck etc. are allowed by section 145-51 B (2) to be there as it is not a residential zone and they are not visible from the other properties. All the "junk" that was observed on this parcel was inside the building and as such would be regulated by whether it had a permit to operate or not and the terms of the permit. In addition, some of the material questioned is not even on this parcel of property.

At this point the question is; are they going to be allowed to operate and if not then the order to remove any materials not allowed could be enforced!
